 Oakland ranks as the "best value for investment" among our peers.





What is AI? Artificial Intelligence (AI) is a blend of technologies that enable machines to act with higher levels of intelligence and emulate human capabilities.



Significance in Education: Al's potential to revolutionize learning, teaching, and administrative functions in higher education through automation, personalization, and efficiency.



Enhancements: All can customize learning to individual student needs, streamline research by analyzing vast datasets, and automate routine tasks, allowing staff to focus on more strategic activities.

Challenges: Ethical dilemmas, such as data privacy concerns, risk of bias in AI algorithms, job security for administrative staff, and maintaining the integrity of academic work.

Leadership Response: In recognition of Al's pivotal role and its dualedged impact on higher education, President Pescovitz has instituted an Al Task Force.


The Task Force is charged with a comprehensive evaluation of Al's opportunities and challenges within the realms of academic research and education.








