WRT 260 Writing Across the University: Language and Disciplinary Culture (4) Interdisciplinary examination of diverse strategies for writing and research in the humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences. Introduces theories of language as social and cultural action. Students build upon prior knowledge and increase their effectiveness as writers and researchers. Includes individual, collaborative, and field based research projects. Prerequisite: WRT 160 or equivalent with a grade of 2.0 or higher.
