



General Education Requirements

Students must complete 40 credits of general education, excluding U.S. Diversity, Capstone and Writing Intensive in the Major. Each category must be fulfilled by completing one course of at least 3 or more credits. Courses used to meet Writing, Formal Reasoning, Arts, Foreign Language and Culture, Global Perspective, Literature, Natural Science and Technology, Social Science, Western Civilization and Knowledge Applications may not be double counted with each other. U.S. Diversity, Writing Intensive in the Major, and Capstone may be met by double counting approved general education courses. Please see the Oakland University catalog for further information.

- Students may transfer one-half of the credits required for the baccalaureate degree. A minimum of 32 credits must be completed at OU.
- Students transferring 3 credit courses may be required to enroll in additional course credits to reach the required minimums for Oakland University.
- Lower level courses that transfer in as upper level Oakland University courses will not be counted as 300-400 level credit to meet OU/Major degree requirements.

- Students who transfer with the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) or Michigan Association of Collegiate Registrar and Admissions Officers (MACRAO) Articulation Agreement satisfy the university's general education requirements with the exception of a writing intensive course in the major and a capstone course. Students must also either transfer in a course that is acceptable for the knowledge applications requirement or take a course at Oakland University.
