<p>Admission to the Bachelor of Social Work degree program is based on the following criteria: a minimum overall GPA of 2.80; completion of all program prerequisite courses (SOC 100, PSY 100, PS 100, BIO 104/111) with a grade of 2.0 or higher; completion of SOC/SW 210 with a grade of 3.0 or higher; experience in the human services field (employment or volunteer work including work completed for SW 210); two letters of reference (one from a supervisor in a human services agency); and a personal written statement from students.</p>
