3. Arts	Satisfied by THA 1000 at OU
4. Foreign Language and Culture	Satisfied by ALS 1101 at OU Modern Language majors choose one from the following Languages JAPA 101, 102, FREN, SPAN 101, 102, 201, 202
5. Global Perspective	Satisfied by GEO 2000 at OU
6. Literature	LITE 205, 206, 211, 212, 222, 223, 240, 241 (Language Arts- will need an additional credit)
7. Natural Science and Technology	BIOL 101, GEOG 100
8. Social Science	POSC 200, 201, 210
9. Western Civilization	HST 103, 104
10. *Knowledge Applications	Typically taken at OU (see your SEHS Academic Advisor at OU for details)

- Students must have a minimum cumulative transfer GPA of 2.5 in order to be admitted to the pre-elementary education curriculum.
