SPECIAL NOTE: Community College courses that are equivalent to 3000-level OU courses do not count toward the minimum 24 credits in 3000-4000 level PHL courses that are required for the Philosophy major; therefore, fulfilling all the above requirement areas with Mott courses will result in additional 3000+ PHL credits needed to meet the major requirement. Consult with OU adviser for assistance determining most efficient course of action in fulfilling the 3000-4000 level requirement.

Students who complete MTA or MACRAO according to this guide satisfy general education categories 1-9 and U.S. Diversity.

Recent Course Changes:

HIST 152 may be used to satisfy either the Global Perspective or Western Civilization category of General Education, must be transferred in before the start of Fall Semester 2019.

HIST 151 may be used to satisfy the Western Civilization General Education category, must be transferred in before the start of Fall Semester 2019

EXPLORATORY:

Students with majors in the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) must satisfy an exploratory requirement. This can be done by completing a double major or a CAS minor or concentration; or by completing a minimum of 12 credits in a single CAS rubric, outside of their major rubric. For additional options visit oakland.edu/exploratory. Only courses that are at the 100-level or above may be used to fulfill the exploratory requirement. Students using MTA or MACRAO must complete the exploratory requirement at Oakland University or another four-year institution.
