**Recent Course Changes:**

**HIST 152 may be used to satisfy either the Global Perspective or Western Civilization category of General Education, must be transferred in before the start of Fall Semester 2019.**

**HIST 151 may be used to satisfy the Western Civilization General Education category, must be transferred in before the start of Fall Semester 2019**

**EXPLORATORY:**

Students with majors in the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) must satisfy an exploratory requirement. This can be done by completing a double major or a CAS minor or concentration; or by completing a minimum of 12 credits in a single CAS rubric, outside of their major rubric. Students using MTA or MACRAO must complete the exploratory requirement at Oakland University or another four-year institution.
