Students who complete MTA or MACRAO according to this guide satisfy general education categories 1-9 and U.S. Diversity.

NOTES:

Students may transfer one-half of the credits required for the baccalaureate degree. A minimum of 32 credits must be completed at OU.

Students who transfer 3 credit courses may be required to enroll in additional course credits to reach the required minimums for Oakland University.

Courses that transfer in as upper level will not be counted as 300-400 level credit to meet OU/Major degree requirements.
