Recent Changes to OU transfer credit equivalency:

- -OCC HIS 1520 may be used to satisfy OU Global Perspective or Western Civilization category of General Education, must be transferred in before the start of Fall Semester 2019.
- -OCC HIS 1510 may be used to satisfy OU Western Civilization General Education category, must be transferred in before the start of Fall Semester 2019.

- Math prerequisites: MAT 1100 = MTH 0661 at OU, MAT 1150 = MTH 0662 at OU
