- Students may transfer one-half of the credits required for the baccalaureate degree. A minimum of 32 credits must be completed at OU.
 - Students who transfer 3 credit courses may be required to enroll in additional course credits to reach the required minimums for Oakland University.
 - Courses that transfer in as upper level will not be counted as 300-400 level credit to meet OU/Major degree requirements.
