Upon Graduation students will earn a Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education  
 Graduates are eligible for recommendation to the Michigan Department of Education for a Standard Teaching Certificate  
 All subjects K-5, all subjects in a self-contained classroom 6-8 grade, and in endorsed area 6-8 grade  
 \*Participation is required in a public school classroom field experience, assigned by School and Field Services  
 \*\*NSTN Gen Ed meets the prerequisite, HS 2000 and LIN 1182 cannot be used to meet the prerequisite

**Summary of Degree Requirements :**

1. Complete a minimum of 132 credits to earn a Bachelors Degree in Elementary Education
2. Meet university General Education requirements with a C (or 2.0) in each course
3. Complete one teaching major with a B- (or 2.7) in each course  
major options include: Early Childhood, Integrated Science, Language Arts, Mathematics, or Social Studies
4. Complete a 20-credit planned program with EED 3220, EED 4180, EED 4181, MTD 3001 and three additional core content area courses outside of your major. The plan outlined above covers this requirement
5. Apply for major standing once enrolled in EED 2000 or 2001, 2.8 GPA is required to in order to apply
6. All professional courses require a B (or 3.0) and may not be older than six years upon graduation
7. In order to be eligible for a Michigan Teaching Certificate, graduates must be in compliance with all legal curricular requirements

**Requirements for Major Standing in Elementary Education**[Forms available online](#)

1. Meeting the basic skills requirement for the State of Michigan, which can be met using minimum SAT scores of 480 in Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and 530 in Mathematics. Official scores must be sent to OU from the SAT
2. Completion of 12 credits of General Education coursework with a minimum grade of a C (or 2.0) in each course
3. 60 documented clock hours experience working with children ages 4-14 in noncustodial activities. Field experience in EED 2000/2001 meets 30 hours of this requirement. Examples of activities and documentation forms are available on the SEHS Advising website
4. EED 2000 or 2001 with a minimum grade of B (or 3.0)
5. MTH 0662 with a minimum grade of C (or 2.0) or placement beyond MTH 0662 with ACT or SAT scores
6. A cumulative grade point average of 2.8 or higher
7. Completed Major Standing Application and Acknowledgement Form
