

Articulation Agreement Between Oakland University and Macomb Community College For an Associate of Applied Science in Education: Early Childhood Studies to a Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education

Effective August 1, 2024 - July 31, 2029

- Complete the Associate in Applied Science in Education: Early Childhood Studies at Macomb Community College.
- Complete MTA. It is highly recommended that students complete MTA before transferring to OU. Students who choose not to complete the MTA will be required to complete any outstanding General Education requirements upon transferring to OU. This may require additional credits. MTA course suggestions are below:
 - ENGL 1190 Communications 2 or ENGL 1220 Composition 2 (must complete with a B or better)
- **Complete** the following additional requirements outside the Associate in Applied Science in Education: Early Childhood Studies. May require a 5th semester at Macomb.
 - MATH 1280 Mathematics for Education 1
 - Knowledge Applications Gen Ed: JOUR 1100, PSYC 2450, SPCH 1010 or SPCH 1060 recommended

Notes:

- Oakland University's Early Childhood Education program starts each Fall semester
- A minimum of 120 credits are required to complete the Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education. Additional credits beyond 120 may be required to complete all general education requirements and major requirements.
- Students must have a minimum GPA of 2.8 in order to take Early Childhood Education coursework
- The Early Childhood Education program prepares students to earn a Bachelor of Science degree and recommendation for a Michigan Teaching Certificate
- Passing scores on Michigan Tests for Teacher Certification (MTTC) are required for Michigan Teaching Certification.
- Early Childhood Education students complete field experiences with early childhood general and special education students in preschools, home visits, and other early intervention settings. Student teaching is in an inclusive or early childhood special education preschool
