

Articulation Agreement Between Oakland University and Campus to the Bachelor of Interdisciplinary Studies program

Exhibit 1: August 1, 2024 – July 31, 2029

The Bachelor of Interdisciplinary Studies (BIS) Program allows students to custom design their academic coursework in order to prepare them for their career aspirations. Students enrolled in the Associate in Arts in Business Administration program will have the opportunity to complete their Plan of Study at Campus, then take the remaining credits at Oakland University to graduate with a Bachelor of Interdisciplinary Studies degree.

## Outline of the Agreement

- Complete the Associate of Arts in Business Administration degree at Campus
- Complete one course from the remaining OU General Education subjects below. Click the <u>General Education</u> requirement link to view approved courses in each subject area. Equivalent courses can be found using Oakland's <u>transfer equivalency tool</u> (this can be done before a student transfer or completed at Oakland University)
  - o Arts
  - Natural Science and Technology
  - Language and Culture
  - Global Perspectives
  - o Literature
  - Western Civilization
  - Knowledge Applications
- Complete the following at Oakland University (minimum 64 credits):
  - Complete OU's General Education requirements listed above (if not completed prior to transferring)
  - Complete at least 32 credits at the 3000 or 4000 level including major courses:
    - BIS 3000 Introductory to Interdisciplinary Studies (4)
    - BIS 4930 Interdisciplinary Research (4)
  - Complete any remaining credits to achieve 120 (minimum graduation requirement) with the help of your BIS advisor

## Application process at Oakland University

- It is recommended to apply to Oakland at the start of your final quarter at Campus.
- Complete the online application it's free!
- Have your official transcripts sent from all previously attended institutions regardless of whether or not credit was actually earned. The application process requires that students list all institutions attended.
- To qualify for admission, students must:
  - Possess a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 (on a 4.0 scale)
  - Submit an official application form and any required documentation (e.g., official college transcripts)

- Fulfill all other admission criteria required of incoming transfer students in accordance with then applicable OU policies and/or procedures, which may be amended from time to time.
- Contact a BIS Advisor after acceptance to go over your transfer plan at <u>bis@oakland.edu</u> or (248) 370-3229.
- Students are required to have at least a 2.0 GPA and a C- or better in their **individual coursework** to be considered for Admission.
- Students who transfer having completed the AABA and have a minimum of 56 credit hours, before enrolling, will enter as having junior class standing at Oakland University.
- Final transcripts must also be submitted upon completion of your final semester, showing you have successfully completed an Associate's degree.
