# Collaboration: OUSC



**ACTIVE SHOOTER PROCEDURES**

**Run**

- Have an escape route in mind
- If the active shooter is a considerable distance away, quickly move away.
- If the armed person is in your area and it is safe to do so, run as far away as possible.
- Leave all personal belongings behind.

**Hide**

- If running is not an option, **hide**.
- Find the area of the room that is not visible through any windows or doors.
- Turn off all lights, computers, projectors, or any lights.
- Stay completely covered.
- Do not open the door to the room by any means.
- Block the doors with heavy items.

**Fight**

- Fighting should be only used when your life is in imminent danger.
- Collect any heavy or sharp objects to throw at the shooters.
- Be ready to try to incapacitate the shooter by any means necessary.

**Register For Emergency Notifications**


- Register for the Emergency Notification System on the OUPD website under "Emergency Alerts."

**Locate Exits**

Always take a moment to survey the space you're in and **locate** any and **all exits** in the room, including windows. This ensures that you are less likely to freeze in the event of an emergency.

**Talk About It!**

Have open conversations with those around you (peers, faculty, colleagues, roommates, etc.) about what you can do to prepare. Having these difficult conversations before an emergency arises can **save time and lives**.
