IMPORTANT NOTES

1. **Courses numbered 4900** may be repeated for credit provided the topics are different.
2. **Full year registration** begins every March. Students may begin registration in order of class standing (according to credits earned.) All registration dates are published on the Registrar's Office website: oakland.edu/registrar
3. **Prerequisites** are enforced for all business courses. View pre-reqs on SAIL or on the SBA Advising website: oakland.edu/business/advising
4. **Double majors** are permitted except for General Management. General Management may not be combined with any other business major; however, minors may be earned with a General Management major.
