

# **About Oakland University**

Oakland University was created in 1957, when the late Alfred and Matilda Wilson donated \$2 million and their 1,500–acre estate to Michigan State University to begin a new college in Oakland County.

Named Michigan State University-Oakland, the new campus enrolled its first 570 students in 1959. In 1963, its name changed to Oakland University as the first class graduated with 125 students receiving diplomas. In 1970, the Michigan Legislature recognized the maturity and stature of the University by granting it autonomy, and the governor appointed Oakland University's first Board of Trustees.

From its beginnings, the University has emphasized academic quality, concentrating on providing a dynamic, student-focused learning environment with integration of liberal and professional studies by a faculty of dedicated scholar-teachers. The natural beauty of the campus, much of it still wooded and undeveloped, is enhanced by comprehensive recreational facilities and modern buildings that house the University's many academic and public service programs as well as more than 2,000 residential students.

Dedicated to preparing graduates to make meaningful and substantial contributions to the workplace, society and academia, the University is organized into eight academic units: the College of Arts and Sciences; the schools of Business Administration, Education and Human Services, Engineering and Computer Science, Health Sciences, Medicine, and Nursing; and The Honors College.

Oakland has 146 bachelor degree programs and 134 graduate degree and certificate programs. Doctorates are offered in education with concentrations in educational leadership, counseling and early childhood education; biomedical sciences with specializations in medical physics, health and environmental chemistry, and biological communication; reading education; systems and mechanical engineering; physical therapy; applied mathematical sciences; nursing practice; music education; computer science and informatics; psychology, medicine, and electrical and computer engineering.

The University is continuously adapting to meet the changing needs of students and the marketplace. New programs delivered online and on campus include master's degree programs in nursing, psychology, training and development, public health, software engineering, an Executive MBA program in health care management, and innovative Honors College courses. Business and industry partnerships provide unprecedented opportunities for advanced, hands-on learning.

Now, over 17,000 students attend classes at Oakland University each year, and the number of OU alumni has increased to more than 135,000.


# **HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT 2023**

# Glenn Ellis, MPH, CHCE, FCPP

Glenn Ellis, a native of Birmingham, Alabama, is President/Founder of Strategies for Well-Being, LLC, a health education-communications consulting company promoting health ethics and equity.

A respected author, in 2006, his book, Which Doctor? was received with wide acclaim, and Information is the Best Medicine, was released in January of 2012. He is working on his 3rd book, scheduled for release in 2025, on A History of Medicine in Philadelphia.

A writer and columnist, Ellis has contributed to Real Health Magazine, Heart and Soul Magazine, The Black AIDS Institute Newsletter, as well as The National Medical Association's, Healthy Living magazine. In addition to a syndicated weekly column, Ellis remains



Ellis was a member of the Institutional Review Board (IRB) at Thomas Jefferson University; Drexel University; and Mercy Health System, as well as a member of the Executive Continuing Medical Education Committee (EMC) for all 4 acute-care Mercy Hospitals in the Philadelphia area for over 20 years.

He maintains a busy lecture schedule in the U.S. and abroad, where he highlights health disparities and medical ethics. Ellis is well sought-after university guest lecturer, and has made scientific presentations in Belgium, Germany, Cuba, Austria, Africa, Ukraine, and The Netherlands.

Ellis is a Certified Health Care Ethicist (CHCE) and received his master's degree in public health (MPH) at the University of Liverpool. He is a doctoral candidate in Global Bioethics (DBIO) at Euclid University. He is a Fellow at the College of Physicians – Philadelphia.

Glenn's current projects include books on The History of American Medicine's Origins in Philadelphia (2025); a Photojournalism collaboration book on the sociological toll of COVID-19 on the lives of Americans; and a book of narrative essays on Clinical Ethical Dilemmas (2026).





# Walt Young

Walt Young has over 50 years' experience in leading organizations. For the first 36 years, he held senior positions at four public companies: BF Goodrich, The Budd Company, The Henley Group and Champion Enterprises. As Chair and CEO of Champion (Fortune 500) Walt was recognized by Fortune as a "Superstar" and by the Harvard Business School as one of the 100 top business leaders of the twentieth century. While at these four companies he completed 23 different turnarounds and over 75 mergers and acquisitions. Since 2003 Walt has focused on entrepreneurial start-ups, including as a lead investor and Director for Accuri Cytometers (acquired by Becton, Dickinson in 2011), CelSee, Inc.(acquired by Bio-Rad in 2020) and Swift Biosciences, Inc. (acquired by Danaher in 2021). He has led and assisted over 100 entities to raise more than \$150M in capital. Walt is currently on the board of four early stage companies: Eagle River Homes, Weathershield, Nanocerox, and Kroma-



TiD. From 2003 to 2018, Walt was a director at NRG Energy (NYSE:NRG, Fortune 200). Further, his non-profit boards have included Muskingum University, Oakland University Foundation and Gleaners Food Bank of Southeast Michigan.

Walt received a BA in History and Economics from Muskingum University, his MBA in Marketing and Management from Penn State University and an honorary doctorate in Public Service from Muskingum University.

# Donna Young

Donna Young received her B.A. from Muskingum University in New Concord, Ohio. After receiving her degree, Donna proofread and edited classified reports for HRB Singer in State College, Pennsylvania. Donna also worked as a nursing school librarian at Akron City Hospital. Upon her retirement from the work world, Donna began her career as a mother and a volunteer. Her volunteer work included working with a hospital-based program for new mothers, leading Brownie and Girl Scout troops, a Cub Scout den, tutoring a Japanese ESL student, serving in various PTA positions including President, and participating in the Kids on the Block program (an in-school puppet presentation of disabled children that aided to create empathy and understanding). At Northbrook Church, she served as an elder, clerk of session, Stephen minister, chair of a pastor search committee, the mission (the longest-standing commitment), and participated in various other committees. Her com-





munity involvement began as a member of the Junior League, by organizing an event for seniors that provided information on alternative housing options. Donna was a member of the former "Friends" group of Oakland Family Services and served on the CEO search committee. At Oakland University she is a member of the Women & Philanthropy group and, with her husband, a supporter of the Honors College study abroad program. Since its inception in 1994, she has been the secretary/treasurer of The Young Foundation, providing grants to human services organizations in the Pontiac area.

# Wendel A. White

Wendel A. White was born in Newark, New Jersey and grew up in New York, Pennsylvania, and New Jersey. He was awarded a BFA in photography from the School of Visual Arts in New York and an MFA in photography from the University of Texas at Austin. White taught photography at the School of Visual Arts, NY; The Cooper Union for the Advancement of Science and Art, NY; the International Center for Photography, NY; Rochester Institute of Technology; and is currently Distinguished Professor of Art & American Studies at Stockton University.

He has received various awards and fellowships including the Robert Gardner Fellowship in Photography, Peabody Museum of Archeology & Ethnography, Harvard University; John Simon Guggenheim Foundation Fellowship in Photography; three artist fellowships from



the New Jersey State Council for the Arts; Bunn Lectureship in Photography and grants from EnFoco, Center Santa Fe, the Graham Foundation for Advanced Studies in the Fine Arts, and various artist's residencies.

His work is represented in museum, public, and private collections including National Gallery of Art (DC); Mint Museum (NC); Duke University (NC); New Jersey State Museum (NJ); California Institute for Integral Studies (CA); Graham Foundation for the Advancement of the Fine Arts (IL); En Foco, (NY); Rochester Institute of Technology (NY); The Museum of Fine Art, Houston (TX); Museum of Contemporary Photography, Chicago (IL); Haverford College (PA); University of Delaware (DE); University of Alabama (AL); and Schomburg Center for Research in Black Culture (NY).

White has served on the boards of directors for the Society for Photographic Education, New Jersey Council for the Humanities, and The Print Center (PA). He has also served on the Kodak Educational Advisory Council, NJ Save Outdoor Sculpture, the Atlantic City Historical Museum, Atlantic City Free Library Foundation, New Jersey Martin Luther King Jr. Commission, and the New Jersey Black Culture and Heritage Foundation.

Recent projects include Manifest: Thirteen Colonies; Red Summer; Schools for the Colored; Village of Peace: An African American Community in Israel; Small Towns, Black Lives; and others.

# MACE AND PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

In medieval times, a mace was used in warfare. The mace is one of the oldest traditions in academe dating back to the early 1400's when it transitioned from warfare to ceremonial use. Considered a symbol of the University itself, the scepter mace is carried by the University marshal during commencement, convocation and other ceremonial events to signify the arrival of the faculty processional. Oakland's mace, created in 1994, was crafted by jeweler and OU alumnus, Paul Haig and designer Robert Dobbie of P.R. Haig Jewelers in Rochester.

The 30-inch long, approximately 8-pound mace has a white oak handle trimmed with sterling silver ribbon. A black obsidian disk on top is ringed with silver and is inscribed with the University motto. Obsidian is a natural black glass formed by the earth. On each side of the obsidian disk, there is a 14k yellow gold sail. On the base of the handle, a gold oak tree was modeled after a live tree on campus. The clean, straightforward design of the mace reflects the fact that Oakland University is a contemporary institution.

The President's Medallion, also created in 1994 by the same jeweler, is six inches in diameter and reveals the University sail, hangs on a silver chain and is worn by the president at ceremonial events. It is a permanent part of the University's president's academic regalia.

# **ACADEMIC REGALIA**

An edifying note contributed by a certain anonymous doctor of philosophy.

On at least two solemn occasions during the academic calendar — spring and fall commencement — the faculty of the University publicly displays its full academic regalia and participates in the liturgy of processional and recessional, that curious coming and going that symbolizes the ceremony of commencement. The purposes of commencement are well known, but the reasons for the peculiar garb of the celebrants and their odd order of march are often as obscure to the audience as they are, in fact, to the faculty itself. This note may serve to explain academic dress and the professional pecking order it costumes.

Contemporary academics are descendants of clerical schoolmen in the universities of medieval Europe. Like the clergy, members of the bench and bar, and other learned professions, medieval scholars were clothed in



heavy robes to stay warm in unheated stone buildings. Like all members of a hierarchical society, the medieval faculties rejoiced in visible insignia of rank. These outward signs of accomplishment and authority were tailored into robes. Although the need for such voluminous garments to keep the scholar from freezing is long past, the use of them as emblems of dignity remains. You will observe that all caps and gowns worn by our faculty are black, with certain exceptions. Black was the color adopted by mutual agreement among American universities at the end of the 19th century. In Europe, each University has its own distinctive gown, varying in color and cut from all others.

There are three basic academic degrees: the baccalaureate or bachelor's degree, the master's degree, and the doctorate. A special style of robe is prescribed for each. The bachelor's gown is sparsely cut, neat, but a bit skimpy and unadorned, as befits apprentices. The master's gown is still simple, but fuller, sports a sleeve of extraordinary design impossible to describe, and has a hood draped from the shoulders down the back. Once used to keep the frost from the tonsured heads of medieval clerks, the hood is solely a badge of a degree of scholarly achievement. The master's hood is small and narrow, but displays the colors of the institution that awarded the degree. If you knew the colors of American universities, you could easily identify whence came our masters. The doctoral robe is the most handsome of academic raiment. Generous of cut, of fine aristocratic stuff, it is faced with velvet chevrons on the ample sleeves. You will note that most of the velvet facings and chevrons are black, but that some are of other colors. According to personal taste, the doctor may display the color of his or her doctoral degree on the sleeves and facings: light blue for education, pink for music, apricot for nursing, orange for engineering, and many more. The royal blue of the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) is the most commonly seen in liberal arts institutions such as Oakland. The doctor's hood is the most elegant of all



academic appurtenances. Large and graceful, it is lined in satin with the colors of the University that awarded the degree and is bordered with the color of the degree itself. Most academic costumes include the square cap called a mortarboard; the doctor's tassel may be either black or gold — tassels of all other degrees are black and stringy.

To instructed eyes, the order of march in the processional and recessional reveals the standing of individuals in the institution's formal hierarchy. In the processional, the order of entrance into the hall is, quite fittingly, from most junior to most senior. The baccalaureate candidates enter first, followed successively by the masters and doctoral candidates with the whole separated from the faculty by a decent interval. In the faculty order, the instructors precede the assistant professors that in turn are followed by the associate professors. The august full professors bring up the rear. After a respectful distance come the deans who in turn are separated by a significant space from the awful majesty of the platform party, the vice president, the president, and the members of the board of trustees. All remain standing until the board is seated. After the ceremony, the order of recessional is the reverse of the processional. The greatest dignitaries stream out first, with the artfully organized ranks of priority wallowing in their wake.

It is hoped that these notes may make more intelligible the spectacle you are witnessing today. A discerning intelligence may detect in it many clues to an understanding of the academic profession as it confronts the ambiguities of the future with ancient wisdom and dignified confidence.






