

About Oakland University

Oakland University was created in 1957, when the late Alfred and Matilda Wilson donated \$2 million and their 1,500–acre estate to Michigan State University to begin a new college in Oakland County.

Named Michigan State University-Oakland, the new campus enrolled its first 570 students in 1959. In 1963, its name changed to Oakland University as the first class graduated with 125 students receiving diplomas. In 1970, the Michigan Legislature recognized the maturity and stature of the University by granting it autonomy, and the governor appointed Oakland University's first Board of Trustees.

From its beginnings, the University has emphasized academic quality, concentrating on providing a dynamic, student-focused learning environment with integration of liberal and professional studies by a faculty of dedicated scholar-teachers. The natural beauty of the campus, much of it still wooded and undeveloped, is enhanced by comprehensive recreational facilities and modern buildings that house the University's many academic and public service programs as well as more than 2,000 residential students.

Dedicated to preparing graduates to make meaningful and substantial contributions to the workplace, society and academia, the University is organized into eight academic units: the College of Arts and Sciences; the schools of Business Administration, Education and Human Services, Engineering and Computer Science, Health Sciences, Medicine, and Nursing; and The Honors College.

Oakland has 146 bachelor degree programs and 134 graduate degree and certificate programs. Doctorates are offered in education with concentrations in educational leadership, counseling and early childhood education; biomedical sciences with specializations in medical physics, health and environmental chemistry, and biological communication; reading education; systems and mechanical engineering; physical therapy; applied mathematical sciences; nursing practice; music education; computer science and informatics; psychology, medicine, and electrical and computer engineering.

The University is continuously adapting to meet the changing needs of students and the marketplace. New programs delivered online and on campus include master's degree programs in nursing, psychology, training and development, public health, software engineering, an Executive MBA program in health care management, and innovative Honors College courses. Business and industry partnerships provide unprecedented opportunities for advanced, hands-on learning.

Now, over 17,000 students attend classes at Oakland University each year, and the number of OU alumni has increased to more than 135,000.

Michael T. Trese, Ph.D.

Dr. Michael T. Trese was an adult and pediatric vitreoretinal surgeon who, throughout his nearly 40-year career, made numerous seminal contributions to the field of ophthalmology. Prior to his tenure, pediatric retinal detachments were largely considered hopeless and frequently culminated in irreversible blindness. His simple, yet brilliant observation that pediatric retinal detachments are guided by different principles than adult retinal detachments, has resulted in countless individuals maintaining their sight. These surgical techniques, in particular lens sparing vitrectomy, are now taught the world over.



Through careful clinical observation, Dr. Trese, helped to define the classification criteria for several pediatric vitreoretinal diseases including, retinopathy of prematurity, X-Linked Congenital Retinoschisis and Familial Exudative Vitreoretinopathy. After defining these

criteria, Dr. Trese worked diligently in the laboratory at the Eye Research Institute to develop the first Food and Drug Administration-approved pharmacologic agent for vitreolysis. Additional research conducted at the Pediatric Retinal Research Laboratory at Oakland University, has helped to understand and modulate a critical cellular signaling pathway within the retina that possess the potential to unlock retinal regeneration.

Dr. Trese pioneered imaging systems and software which are used to acquire images and measure retinal landmarks in infants. These advancements paved the way for the tele-screening of premature infants with retinopathy of prematurity and promoted the use of telemedicine within the field of ophthalmology.

In addition to his translational medicine success, Dr. Trese was a consummate educator. He held numerous positions within prestigious professional societies including being the Past President of the Retina Society and the Past President of The Club Jules Gonin. He gave countless invited lectures across the globe, wrote textbooks, book chapters and authored more than 300 peer reviewed articles. He worked closely with the Italian Consulate and had a clinic in Rome where he trained Italian doctors regarding the medical and surgical management of pediatric retinal disease. Because of this he was recognized by the Italian Government as a Cavailiere. In addition, he trained international research fellows from many countries around the world. More recently, he was recognized by the American Academy of Ophthalmology as the 2022 Laureate Award recipient for his numerous contributions. Despite these accolades, Dr. Trese remained steadfast in the belief that his greatest contribution was the vitreoretinal surgical fellows that he trained. Because of all of this, Dr. Trese is largely regarded as the Father of Modern Pediatric Vitreoretinal Surgery.

To be a posthumous recipient of Oakland University's highest honor, Doctor of Science, is a special capstone to a remarkable career. However, Dr. Trese's scientific success did not occur without the dedicated support of the individuals at the Eye Research Institute and The Pediatric Retinal Research Laboratory. It is the sincere hope of the Trese family that Dr. Trese's legacy will act as a foundation of scientific innovation that will make a direct impact in the lives of people with visual impairment.

Lainie Friedman Ross, MD, Ph.D.

Lainie Friedman Ross, MD, Ph.D., joined the University of Rochester in January 2023 as Professor and inaugural Chair, Department of Health Humanities and Bioethics and Director of the Paul M. Schyve MD Center for Bioethics with secondary appointments in the Departments of Pediatrics and Philosophy. Prior to her move, Dr. Ross was the Carolyn and Matthew Bucksbaum Professor of Clinical Medical Ethics; Professor, Departments of Pediatrics, Medicine, Surgery and the College; Co-Director of the Institute for Translational Medicine, and Associate Director of the MacLean Center for Clinical Medical Ethics at the University of Chicago. Clinically, Dr. Ross is a board-certified primary care pediatrician. Dr. Ross earned her undergraduate degree from Princeton University's School of Public and International Affairs (1982), her medical degree from the University of Pennsylvania Perelman School of Medicine (1986), and her doctorate in philosophy from Yale University



(1996). She trained in Pediatrics at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and New York-Columbia Presbyterian Morgan Stanley Children's Hospital.

For Ross, philosophy is important to medicine because moral convictions shape how medicine is practiced, how health institutions are structured and function, and how health policy is designed and implemented. Dual training in philosophy and medicine is uncommon; even rarer is the clinician-philosopher—one who practices clinical medicine and uses philosophy as the tool for one's research. Ross has made major contributions in the ethical and policy issues raised by pediatrics; organ transplantation; genetics; and human subjects protections. Her main focus has been an analytical examination of moral relationships and their implications for health care decision making and health care policies.

In pediatrics, Ross wrote Children, Families, and Health Care Decision Making (Oxford University Press, 1998), which was the first full-length manuscript that addressed the moral underpinning of the triadic pediatric relationship between doctor, patient, and parents. She rejected holding parents to a "best interest of the child" standard because it implies that there is an objective best interest and that we can know what is best for all children in all cases. Instead, she offered a novel framework focused on constrained parental autonomy. Her work has been cited widely.

In transplantation, Ross was the lead author on the 1997 New England Journal of Medicine publication on kidney paired exchange programs that currently accounts for over 1400 transplants annually. She has co-authored the seminal books in deceased donor and living donor transplantation with Bob Veatch and Dick Thistlethwaite respectively.

Dr. Ross has written or co-written 5 books and has published over 200 articles in the peer reviewed literature and another 200 invited articles. She has served on numerous national and international committees in pediatrics, transplantation, and genetics. She was the 2009 recipient of the Patricia Price Brown Prize in Biomedical Ethics from the Oklahoma Health Sciences University, a 2014 recipient of a John Simon Guggenheim Memorial Foundation Fellowship, and the 2015 recipient of the William G. Bartholomew Award in Ethical Excellence from the American Academy of Pediatrics.

Dr. Ross is married to John Ross, and they have 2 grown daughters.

Curtis Armstrong

Curtis Armstrong graduated Oakland University's Academy of Dramatic Arts in 1975 and went on to a career in theatre, film, television and voice-over that continues today. Following his graduation, he appeared at Meadowbrook Theatre for several seasons and founded with members of his graduating class a theatre company, Roadside Attractions, which later became Detroit's Attic Theatre. He appeared in numerous off-Broadway and regional productions and toured nationally in Hugh Leonard's Tony-winning drama, "Da." His film work includes "Risky Business," "Revenge of the Nerds," "Better Off Dead," "Ray," and "Akeelah and the Bee" and his television work includes "Moonlighting," "Supernatural," "The Closer" and "New Girl." He has been a regular voice on "American Dad," "Emperor's New School," and "Monsters at Work." In 2018, he wrote the memoir "Revenge of the Nerd, or The Singular Adventures of the Man Who Was Booger," published by St. Mar-



tin's Press and, with Elliott Milstein, co-authored "A Plum Assignment: Discourses on P.G. Wodehouse and His World," published by Winch and Clutterbuck. His archive is stored at OU's Kresge Library.

MACE AND PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

In medieval times, a mace was used in warfare. The mace is one of the oldest traditions in academe dating back to the early 1400's when it transitioned from warfare to ceremonial use. Considered a symbol of the University itself, the scepter mace is carried by the University marshal during commencement, convocation and other ceremonial events to signify the arrival of the faculty processional. Oakland's mace, created in 1994, was crafted by jeweler and OU alumnus, Paul Haig and designer Robert Dobbie of P.R. Haig Jewelers in Rochester.

The 30-inch long, approximately 8-pound mace has a white oak handle trimmed with sterling silver ribbon. A black obsidian disk on top is ringed with silver and is inscribed with the University motto. Obsidian is a natural black glass formed by the earth. On each side of the obsidian disk, there is a 14k yellow gold sail. On the base of the handle, a gold oak tree was modeled after a live tree on campus. The clean, straightforward design of the mace reflects the fact that Oakland University is a contemporary institution.

The President's Medallion, also created in 1994 by the same jeweler, is six inches in diameter and reveals the University sail, hangs on a silver chain and is worn by the president at ceremonial events. It is a permanent part of the University's president's academic regalia.



ACADEMIC REGALIA

An edifying note contributed by a certain anonymous doctor of philosophy.

On at least two solemn occasions during the academic calendar — spring and fall commencement —the faculty of the University publicly displays its full academic regalia and participates in the liturgy of processional and recessional, that curious coming and going that symbolizes the ceremony of commencement. The purposes of commencement are well known, but the reasons for the peculiar garb of the celebrants and their odd order of march are often as obscure to the audience as they are, in fact, to the faculty itself. This note may serve to explain academic dress and the professional pecking order it costumes.

Contemporary academics are descendants of clerical schoolmen in the universities of medieval Europe. Like the clergy, members of the bench and bar, and other learned professions, medieval scholars were clothed in



heavy robes to stay warm in unheated stone buildings. Like all members of a hierarchical society, the medieval faculties rejoiced in visible insignia of rank. These outward signs of accomplishment and authority were tailored into robes. Although the need for such voluminous garments to keep the scholar from freezing is long past, the use of them as emblems of dignity remains. You will observe that all caps and gowns worn by our faculty are black, with certain exceptions. Black was the color adopted by mutual agreement among American universities at the end of the 19th century. In Europe, each University has its own distinctive gown, varying in color and cut from all others.

There are three basic academic degrees: the baccalaureate or bachelor's degree, the master's degree, and the doctorate. A special style of robe is prescribed for each. The bachelor's gown is sparsely cut, neat, but a bit skimpy and unadorned, as befits apprentices. The master's gown is still simple, but fuller, sports a sleeve of extraordinary design impossible to describe, and has a hood draped from the shoulders down the back. Once used to keep the frost from the tonsured heads of medieval clerks, the hood is solely a badge of a degree of scholarly achievement. The master's hood is small and narrow, but displays the colors of the institution that awarded the degree. If you knew the colors of American universities, you could easily identify whence came our masters. The doctoral robe is the most handsome of academic raiment. Generous of cut, of fine aristocratic stuff, it is faced with velvet chevrons on the ample sleeves. You will note that most of the velvet facings and chevrons are black, but that some are of other colors. According to personal taste, the doctor may display the color of his or her doctoral degree on the sleeves and facings: light blue for education, pink for music, apricot for nursing, orange for engineering, and many more. The royal blue of the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) is the most commonly seen in liberal arts institutions such as Oakland. The doctor's hood is the most elegant of all



academic appurtenances. Large and graceful, it is lined in satin with the colors of the University that awarded the degree and is bordered with the color of the degree itself. Most academic costumes include the square cap called a mortarboard; the doctor's tassel may be either black or gold — tassels of all other degrees are black and stringy.

To instructed eyes, the order of march in the processional and recessional reveals the standing of individuals in the institution's formal hierarchy. In the processional, the order of entrance into the hall is, quite fittingly, from most junior to most senior. The baccalaureate candidates enter first, followed successively by the masters and doctoral candidates with the whole separated from the faculty by a decent interval. Governor Gretchen Whitmer

Governor Gretchen Whitmer is a lifelong Michigander who is focused on getting things done that will make a real difference in people's lives. As governor, she has signed over 1,000 bipartisan bills and four balanced, bipartisan budgets to deliver on the kitchen-table issues, grow the economy, and create good-paying jobs in every region of the state.

Since the governor took office, Michigan has announced 35,000 auto jobs, fixed 16,000 lane miles of road and 1,200 bridges, and funded programs putting tens of thousands of people on tuition-free paths to higher education and skills training. 





Korin Visocchi, Ph.D.

Dr. Korin Visocchi is an educational leader and retired rock-and-roll star who marvels at how her unique journey in the music industry unexpectedly influences her best practices as an educational leader. Her story draws from 20 years of crossover lessons and experiences touring from California to France, teaching from Detroit to Lansing, and guiding institutions through economic downturns and COVID-19. It is a joyful tale of plot twists and road blocks, but with a clear path forward for anyone, at any stage of their life journey.

Korin entered her undergraduate experience at Michigan State University with bright eyes and a love for music and reading. While earning degrees in History and International Studies in MSU's Honor College, she began gigging with her then boyfriend Augie (now husband of 15 years) at dive bars and dorms performing original music with their band, The



Hard Lessons. As they unexpectedly began to gain national recognition, Korin simultaneously earned a Master's degree in Education from the University of Michigan.

Swapping school books for a microphone and electric keyboard, Korin and The Hard Lessons soon booked national tours and music publishing placements with Grey's Anatomy, Friday Night Lights, and Chevrolet while opening for everyone from Kings of Leon and My Chemical Romance to Rusted Root and Iggy Pop and the Stooges. After nearly a decade of adventure and non-stop touring, Korin made the difficult decision to stop performing and get back in the classroom. Embracing the intersection of rock and roll and education, Korin found her footing in the educational leadership space, discovering the weight authentic stories play in influencing confidence and real-world change.

Combining an interest in history and leadership through her dissertation research at Oakland University, Korin focused on the formation and life experiences of women educational leaders. Her findings provide a platform for using self-reflection to advance leadership development stories. Since earning her Ph.D in Educational Leadership from Oakland University (and walking across this same stage!) Korin has elevated her career by serving in roles as Chief Learning Officer and Executive Director and is an expert in school accreditation, coaching and strategic planning.

Dr. Visocchi's remarkable journey has been fueled with an unrelenting passion for learning and empowerment. When not helping to build joyful learning communities through storytelling and humor, Korin can be found with her two kids and husband riding bikes, camping, cooking pasta or watching Jeopardy. She may have put a pause on her rock and roll career, but her love of music is perennial. Korin is still humming along to records at home, dancing in the kitchen, and singing harmonies in a local jazz ensemble. Most importantly, she makes an effort every day to find the beauty in all things.
