

MEANINGFUL PARTICIPATION PROGRAM (MPP)

All Oakland University William Beaumont School of Medicine faculty members with a standard appointment are required to participate in the Meaningful Participation Program. The program assures the involvement of faculty members and the reporting tool allows faculty to document their contributions within the School of Medicine. Faculty members must complete the two requirements at least 3 months before their current appointment ends, or you risk losing your OUWB faculty appointment.

Professional Development – 3 credits required

These are activities that the Faculty member has learned something for their profession or for faculty training. This could be done in person or over the internet.

Helpful Tips for Entering Professional Development Credits:

1. Grand Rounds, M&M and Tumor Board have to be through Beaumont to claim credit. If they are attending it and just taking in the information, then it will belong under Professional Development.

Service – 9 credits required

These are activities that the faculty member has provided their knowledge or wisdom to others.

Helpful Tips for Entering Service Credits:

Report Yearly

1. Committees
2. Beaumont Fellowship Program Director
3. Beaumont Residency Program Director
4. Mentors
5. Course/Clerkship Director
6. Elective Director
7. Journal Club

Report Per Session

1. Lectures in a CME setting
2. Lectures to OUWB students, Beaumont Residents or Beaumont Fellows
3. Facilitator for M&M, Grand Rounds or Tumor Board sessions through Beaumont
4. Lectures in a Community

*If a lecture with the same title is given more than once in the same day, make sure to include morning, afternoon or time slot in the description, to show that more than one lecture was given that day.

Other Helpful Information

1. Students have to be OUWB, except for community service, high school students are good.
2. Residents and Fellows have to be through Beaumont
3. Grand Rounds, M&M and Tumor Board have to be through Beaumont to claim credit. If they are a facilitator or presenter this would go under Service (Educational Related).
4. Educational Related lists the activities for OUWB Students, Beaumont Residents, Beaumont Fellows, and lectures.
5. Community Service has to be medical related.

LOGGING INTO MPP

After you have received a faculty appointment with OUWB. Faculty Affairs will add you to the MPP program. To login to this program, you must request a magic login link. This link, sent to your email, will allow you to login without a username or password. Just so you know, the link will automatically expire after 10 minutes.
