AOA Honor Medical Society Inducts OUWB Students

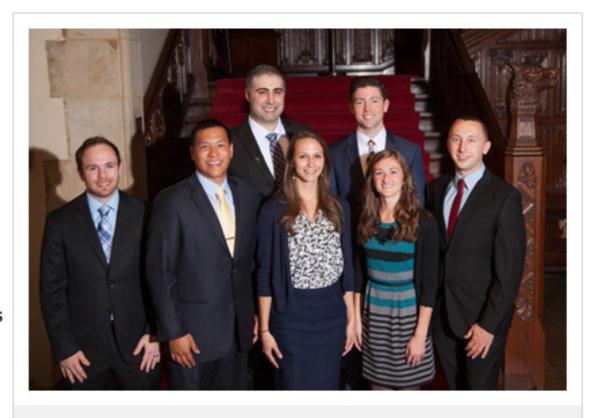
