

Beaumont ranked #1 in the nation for patient survival at one year after kidney transplant

Kidney failure is a serious complication of diabetes, high blood pressure and other diseases. Kidney transplantation offers a chance at a new life for those living with this condition. Since its inception in 1972, our specialists at Beaumont Multi-organ Transplant Center's kidney transplant program have performed over two thousand kidney transplants. The time from wait-listing to kidney transplant for our patients has been 2 years shorter on average compared to Michigan and National wait-times since 2004.

We have had the best outcomes for adult kidney transplants in the state of Michigan since 2000 - as reported by the Scientific Registry of Transplant Recipients (SRTR)*. Recently, we are proud to announce that, Beaumont's risk-adjusted one year patient survival after kidney transplant is ranked the best in the nation among two hundred and fifty five programs (source: www.SRTR.org; Program-Specific Reports, June 2015).

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
