How to Create a QR Code

The code on the left is a link to a video about Audacity. The code on the right is a link to a You Tube video about Raptivity. The code on the last page is a link to the OUWB SOM EIT website.

Create and/or choose your link to your movie, art work, animation, website or video you would like to link to with the QR code.

Place/make sure the element is in an online environment (on a web page or on a You Tube channel).

Visit the link to the online element. Copy the link.

Visit the website (see below) of the QR code generator: http://qrcode.kaywa.com/



Paste the URL of your website in the URL space.

Click the radio button to indicate your content type "URL".

Click "URL" to create the link to the video.

Use the pull-down menu to indicate the size of the QR-Code icon.

Click on the "Generate" radio button and the image of the QR code will be created.

When the code is created you can save the code's permalink or copy and paste the html code.

Click on the image of the code itself and save it as a .png file to your desktop to be later inserted on a poster, on a business card or into a document.

On your cell phone, download an App like QRAFTER Pro, QR Code Reader and Scanner for iPhone, or AT&T Code Scanner etc..

Using your cell phone and the QR Code reader App you installed, point and shoot a picture of the QR-Code reader icon on the poster or paper

Follow instructions on your phone to view the movie, website, etc.. The movie, etc. will download and play on your phone.
