Submissions should be sent in Microsoft Word format via U.S. mail to Managing Editor, *Oakland Journal*, Writing Center, 212 Kresge Library, Oakland University, Rochester, MI 48309 or by email to TOJ@oakland.edu. We prefer email submissions.
