

## GENERAL EDUCATION

Below are the two options available for satisfying Oakland University's General Education requirement. Choosing which way to go can depend on a variety of things such as; the choice of major, previously completed coursework and the timing of transfer. For details on which option may be best for your situation, please consult with an OU academic adviser.

**OPTION #1: Completing OU's General Education requirement when transferring with MTA or MACRAO**

In many cases it is to a student's advantage to complete the MTA agreement to fulfill OU's General Education requirement (please confirm courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your Kellogg academic adviser). When transferring MTA or MACRAO, you must also satisfy the Knowledge Applications category from the table below (#10).

**OPTION #2: Completing OU's General Education requirement by individual category**

For this option, each of the below categories must be fulfilled by completing at least one course of 3 or more credits. A course may not be used in more than one of the categories numbered 1-10.

**U.S. Diversity** – When a course is approved for both the U.S. Diversity requirement and one of the categories numbered 1-10, it may count toward both requirements.

9. <b>Western Civilization</b>	HIST 103, (104 or 104H), (151 or 151H), (152 or 152H), 201, 202, 240; PHIL (201 or 201H), 202
10. <b>Knowledge Applications</b>	<b>Must be outside of OU Major area (confirm course choice with OU adviser)</b> ART 161; COMM 207; FREN 201, 202; JOUR 112; MATH 142; PHYS 112, 222; PSYC 220; SOC 206; SPAN 201, 202
<b>U.S. Diversity</b> – When a course is approved for both this and one of the above categories, it may count toward both requirements.	HIST 103, (104 or 104H), 240; LITE 240; POSC (201 or 201H); SOC (201 or 201H), 206

**NOTES:**

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Kellogg, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Kellogg academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

Additional General Education requirements (Capstone & Writing Intensive in Major) are required to be completed at OU.

The MACRAO stamp will always be recognized by Oakland University.
