

Bachelor of Arts with a major in English Language Arts for Educators

At the undergraduate level, the Combined BA/MAT program allows students to apply for and receive delayed admission into the MAT program.

COREQUISITES: Select from the two options below

An introductory two-semester sequence in a language:	ARBC, CHI, GERM, JAPA, RUSN, (111 and 112) or ASL 100 and 102 or FREN 151 and 152 or SPAN 181 and 182
One semester of a language at the second semester or higher:	ARBC, CHI, GERM, JAPA, RUSN, (112, 211 or 212) OR ASL 100, SLIE 103 or SLIE 204 OR FREN 152, 251 or 252 OR SPAN 182, 281 or 282

***Please Note: Education majors must complete WRT 1060 (or its equivalent) with a minimum grade of B or 3.0.**

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Mott, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Mott counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Mott or at the [Mott MTA Approved Courses](#) website. To most efficiently satisfy OU's transferable General Education requirements, you are also encouraged to reference the [Mott General Education Transfer Guide](#) and select the following:

- One course from OU's **Writing Foundations** category (**B/3.0 minimum** required for education majors) (*this serves as an **MTA English Composition** course and is a prerequisite for coursework at OU*)

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. For this major, the College of Arts and Sciences Exploratory Requirement is met with required coursework.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.

The College of Arts and Sciences requires that a minimum of 16 credits in the major be completed at Oakland University.
