When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Muskegon or at the [Muskegon MTA Approved Courses](#) website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.

**Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide
(minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):**

- ENG 101 (required prerequisite for coursework at OU)
- One MTA Approved English Composition or Communications course (can be satisfied by ENG 102)
- One MTA Approved Math course (can be satisfied by MATH elective options above)
- One MTA Approved Natural Sciences course (can be satisfied by CHEM or PHYS elective options above)
- One MTA Approved Social Sciences course (can be satisfied by SOC 101)
- Two MTA Approved Humanities or Fine Arts courses

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Muskegon, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Muskegon academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
