- Complete Honors Thesis for 8 credits (PSY 4998 and PSY 4999)
- File the appropriate “Application for Departmental Honors in Psychology” form with the Administrative Secretary by the 6<sup>th</sup> week of the semester of Honors II (PSY 4999)

**Due Date Guidelines:**

- By Week 12 of Honors II (PSY 4999) – Defend or present thesis to Committee
- By First day of Finals Week of Honors II (PSY 4999) – Turn in final Thesis to Adviser and Administrative Secretary
