- Students may transfer one-half of the credits (65cr) required for the baccalaureate degree. A minimum of 32 credits must be taken at OU.
- Students must have a minimum cumulative transfer GPA of 2.80 in order to be admitted to the pre-elementary education curriculum.
- A 2.5 "B-" is required for each course applied to the teaching major or teaching minor.
- One teaching major or two teaching minor endorsements are required as part of the Elementary Education degree. The additional credits for a major or minor in Integrated Science may be earned by completing course options listed on the SEHS web site at Oakland University. Students opting for a teaching minor in Integrated Science will need to complete an additional teaching major or minor to satisfy State of Michigan certification requirements. - Students should stay in contact with the OU Education Advising Office to remain current on teacher certification requirements.

¹ Students who transfer with the MACRAO agreement satisfy the university's general education requirements with the exception of a writing intensive course in the major and a capstone course. MACRAO transfer students must also either transfer in a course that is acceptable for the knowledge application requirement or take a course at Oakland University.
