

UCUI Meeting Minutes  
Oakland Center 129-30  
10:00-11:00 AM, January 11, 2016

1. Minutes from the 11/23/15 and 12/7/15 UCUI meetings were approved as submitted.
2. Three proposed program modifications from the Department of Political Science were discussed. All three proposals seek to remove PS 303 and add two other courses (PS 250 and PS 255) in three programs (International Relations, Public Administration and Public Policy, and Political Science.) A concern was raised about the potential impact of these changes on students who planned to seek secondary teaching certification. John McEneaney agreed to follow up on this issue with Tuf Francis whose area is secondary social studies in SEHS. A motion was made, seconded, and approved accepting the proposed changes contingent on assurances that the changes will not interfere with students who are seeking secondary social studies teaching certification.
3. A number of questions forwarded to UCUI by the Senate Steering Committee regarding the proposed moribund course policy were discussed. A number of minor changes were proposed to clarify the intent of the policy. Susan Awbrey will respond to the steering committee questions.
4. There was discussion about the university policy that tests not be administered during the last week of the term before the final examination period. There was consensus that the term "examination" should be understood to refer to any quiz, test, or examination.
5. Jackie Wiggins asked the committee about the most appropriate way for the Department of Music Theater and Dance to add a Dance major to their BA and BFA degrees. This will require adding one additional course to these programs. After discussion, there was consensus that this change will require a new program proposal and budget since it creates a new major and adds credits which may have implications for financial aid.
6. Tricia Westergaard reported on a proposed change to the Lean minor in the Human Resource Development degree removing SBA and SECS courses from the list of allowable courses to satisfy the minor. There was consensus that a change of this sort would require a program modification proposal. John McEneaney agreed to follow up with colleagues in HRD about this matter.
7. The committee discussed the current policy on repeating courses. Minor revisions were proposed to more explicitly indicate how many repeated attempts would be allowed and to add material to assure the policy aligns with federal regulations regarding financial aid. Irene Shabazz will bring the final revised policy back to the committee for review.
8. There was discussion about the proposal to transition from the OSH program to the EHS program. There was concern that the OSH termination memo that had been forwarded might jeopardize accreditation for students. There was consensus that the EHS program should be approved before the OSH program is terminated. Darrin Hanna agreed to meet with Charlie McGlothlin to discuss the proposed changes and provide the committee an update at a later meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 11:00 AM.
