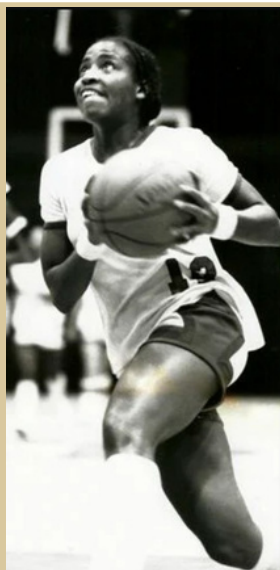


Rep. Brenda Carter (2nd to left) represents the 53rd House District where most PUB Scholars reside.

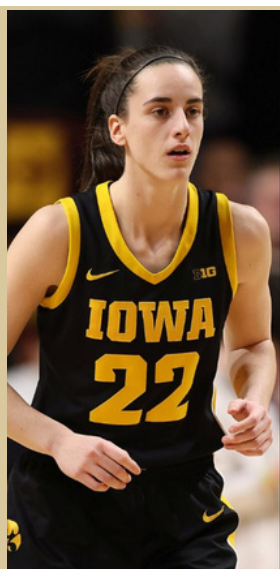


Women's History Month 2024

Pearl Moore set the all-time scoring record for women's collegiate basketball with 4,061 points during her tenure at Francis Marion College from 1975-1979.

She accomplished this under the AIAW governing sports body, as NCAA didn't offer women's basketball tournaments until 1982.

Her career point total of a staggering 4,061 points still remains unbeaten as the overall record in women's hoops!



Women's History Month 2024

Caitlin Clark achieved an NCAA scoring milestone with an astounding 3,650 points, surpassing LSU's Pete Maravich, in her 130th career game against No. 2 Ohio State on March 3, 2024.

"I'm just really thankful and grateful to have those players who have come before me. Yeah, it's super special. Obviously she (Pearl Moore) is one of the best all-time," Clark said. "It just still shows the room that we have to improve, and where women's sports is going is a really great place."
