Note: PSY 251 requires a prerequisite of both PSY 250 and competency in intermediate algebra. Competency is demonstrated by completing MTH 062 –Intermediate Algebra, having an ACT math score of 22 or higher, or taking the math placement exam and achieving a level “R” through the Mathematics and Statistics department. Students should plan to complete the math prerequisites as soon as possible if placement is at or below the MTH 062 level. Students are required to take one course in each of the four domains at the 300-level: Basic Processes (PSY 311, 315, 316, 318, 319, 415, or 416), Developmental (321, 322, 323, 421, 423, 424, or 425), Social (330, 333, 334, 337, 338, 339, or 435), and Personality/Individual Differences (PSY 341, 343, 344, or 445). The term “elective” may not be completely “free” in that this table does not address the university requirements of G.E. Integration or 32 credits at the 300/400 level.
