**SUBJECT: Credit Card and Debit Card
Processing Information Security,
PCI (Payment Card Industry) &
PA-DSS (Payment Application Data
Security Standard) Compliance**

If your department currently accepts or plans on accepting credit or debit card payment for any university purpose, it is important that you understand the rules for compliance. The payment card industry (American Express, Discover Financial Services, JCB, MasterCard Worldwide, and Visa International) created a set of security standards to protect their customers from increasing identity theft and security breaches. The original set of security standards was called Payment Card Industry (PCI) Compliance. The newest set of standards issued for payment applications such as the credit card machines and online payment processing is called Payment Application Data Security Standard (PA-DSS). Oakland University and vendors accepting payments for the university are required to be PCI and PA-DSS compliant because the university accepts credit cards and other types of payment cards for payment.

If your department or operation is considering the purchase of a system that will accept, process, transmit or store credit card information, such as online credit card payments or a similar process, you first need to review critical university policies:

Any contract or purchase that involves software or services accepting payment on behalf of the university must be approved by the Controller's Office and the Purchasing Department.
