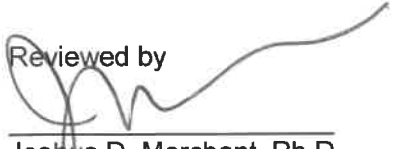
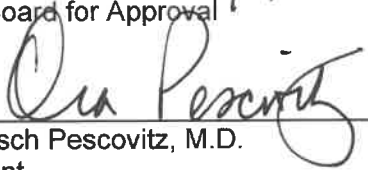


CONSENT AGENDA
