1. Complete Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
2. *Complete Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) requirements
 - a. Meet with Macomb adviser to determine what is needed for MTA
 - b. Below is information to help you in your meeting with a Macomb adviser

MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENTS:

In many cases it is to a student's advantage to complete the MTA or MACRAO agreement when fulfilling General Education requirements. This may allow for more flexibility when creating a schedule while at your community college. When choosing to complete MTA or MACRAO, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic advisor at Macomb or [MTA Approved Courses](#)

3. *Take PSYC 2450 to fulfill OU general education category in Knowledge Applications
4. Submit transcripts to OU. Then 63 credits will be awarded for completion of ADN, OU General Education requirements, and PSYC 2450.
5. An additional 30 credits will be awarded for successful passing of the NCLEX-RN for a total of 93 credits. OU will verify successful completion N-CLEX-RN.
