Notes:

- Students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 in the Associate Degree program to transfer to OU
- Students must apply and be admitted to the OU Bachelor of Science in Applied Health Science with specialization in Radiological Technology Leadership program
- Students must successfully pass the ARRT (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists) exam prior to taking courses in the AHS degree completion sequence.
- Students who do not satisfy MACRAO or MTA at OCC will need to consult with a SHS academic adviser to determine the courses needed to complete the OU General Education requirements.
- Submit transcripts to OU. Then 86-88 credits will be awarded for completion of AAS-RT and OU General Education requirements.
- Up to an additional 28 credits will be awarded for successful passing of the ARRT exam for a total of 114-116 credits.
- OU Coordinator of Medical Imaging Science will verify successful completion ARRT exam.
