

Located near the heart of campus, each residential opportunity is a quick walk from classrooms, computer labs, student services, recreational and dining facilities, Kresge Library and more.

Residents enjoy wireless Internet, cable TV, lounges with big-screen TVs, free parking and laundry facilities.
And all rooms are furnished with:

- extra-long twin or double-sized beds
- plenty of storage space, including dressers, shelves and closets
- free amenities such as cable, Internet and laundry
- desks, chairs and lighting

There are many housing opportunities available, including two student apartment complexes and six residence halls that offer convenience and safety. In fact, OU is one of the safest universities, with a high-level of security and its own police department.

Several off-campus apartment complexes offer additional housing opportunities, including options for international students with families.



You can also participate in OU's International Village, where domestic and international students room together in the Ann V. Nicholson student apartment complex to get a better understanding of each other's cultures, countries and customs. This unique living arrangement is open to any OU student with at

least 56 credits and who is at least 20 years old. The village includes students from countries all around the world.



Located on 1,443 acres of wooded hills and meadows in northern Oakland County, Oakland University is an epicenter of artistic enrichment.


Five cultural gems sit right on campus for you to enjoy:

- Varner Hall houses OU's School of Music, Theatre and Dance (MTD), which hosts year-round student, faculty and guest performances
- Meadow Brook Hall, a National Historic Landmark and the former home of OU's founders, is preserved with the original art and furnishings from the 1920s, including a recently-rediscovered Spanish masterpiece now on display at the Detroit Institute of Arts
- OU Art Gallery, which features innovative painting, sculpture, photography and video by Oakland students and breakthrough artists
- Meadow Brook Amphitheatre, an outdoor summer amphitheatre that has hosted David Gray, Sarah McLachlan and O.A.R.
- Meadow Brook Theatre, Michigan's largest nonprofit professional theatre, which presents everything from Lysistrata Jones to A Christmas Carol

Off campus, you can experience the vibrant downtown of Rochester, named one of the nation's top 10 places for lifelong learning by U.S. News & World Report. Oakland even provides Bear Bus shuttles that take resident students around town for shopping, dining and entertainment outings.

You can also explore neighboring Auburn Hills, home to the Downtown Educational Nook (DEN), and The Palace, which features live concerts as well as Great Lakes Crossing Outlets, Michigan's only enclosed value-regional mall.

STEP 1

Follow the detailed instructions at **oakland.edu/international** for applying. Graduate students should follow the instructions at **oakland.edu/grad/future-graduate-students/international**.

STEP 2

Create an admissions login at **oakland.edu/apply** and record your login information so you can check your application status.

STEP 3

Complete the application. You can apply to OU at any point in the year, but we suggest you submit all the required information, including transcripts and test scores, by these deadlines:

STEP 4

We welcome students from all over the world. International students can come to OU as a/an:

- undergraduate student. Students who are degree-seeking and who have met the English proficiency requirement.
- undergraduate GAPP student. The Global Achievement
 Pathways Program (GAPP) allows students to come to OU with
 lower English proficiency and begin academic study for a degree
 while taking English classes.
- **ESL student.** Students who need to improve their English proficiency before applying for a degree program.
- ASAP student. The American Semester Abroad Program (ASAP) allows undergraduate and graduate students to study abroad at Oakland for a semester or a year and transfer credits back to their home university.
